The Carnival will begin on Friday with Wristband Special, \$20, from 5-9 pm (the only wristband special over the weekend). Like to watch sports? Both the Softball tournament and the Mud Volleyball tournament will begin on Friday evening and will continue throughout the weekend. The Monticello Area Museum will be open Saturday from 10-2. Take a look at an old drug store and a glimpse into the businesses in the early days of Monticello. A special feature includes the many architectural influences of the Steinman brothers. Admission is free. They will have the popcorn machine running.
